The Threat Mitigation Knowledge Hub has been launched on 17th April 2025, by Dr. the Honourable Avinash Ramtohol, Minister of Information Technology, Communication and Innovation, Republic of Mauritius.

The Threat Mitigation Knowledge Hub is managed by the Computer Emergency Response Team of Mauritius (CERT-MU) and has been developed to facilitate the sharing of cyber threat information, help organisations to strengthen their cybersecurity posture, reduce risks, and prevent cyber-attacks.

Formerly known as Maushield, the platform has been completely revamped and rebranded as the Threat Mitigation Knowledge Hub (TMKH), with additional features to better serve the cybersecurity community.

TMKH is a free, membership-based platform open to organisations in both the public and private sectors, including academic institutions. As a member, you can:

- Refer to Malware Analysis Reports New
- Access other resources such as cybersecurity tools, threat reports
